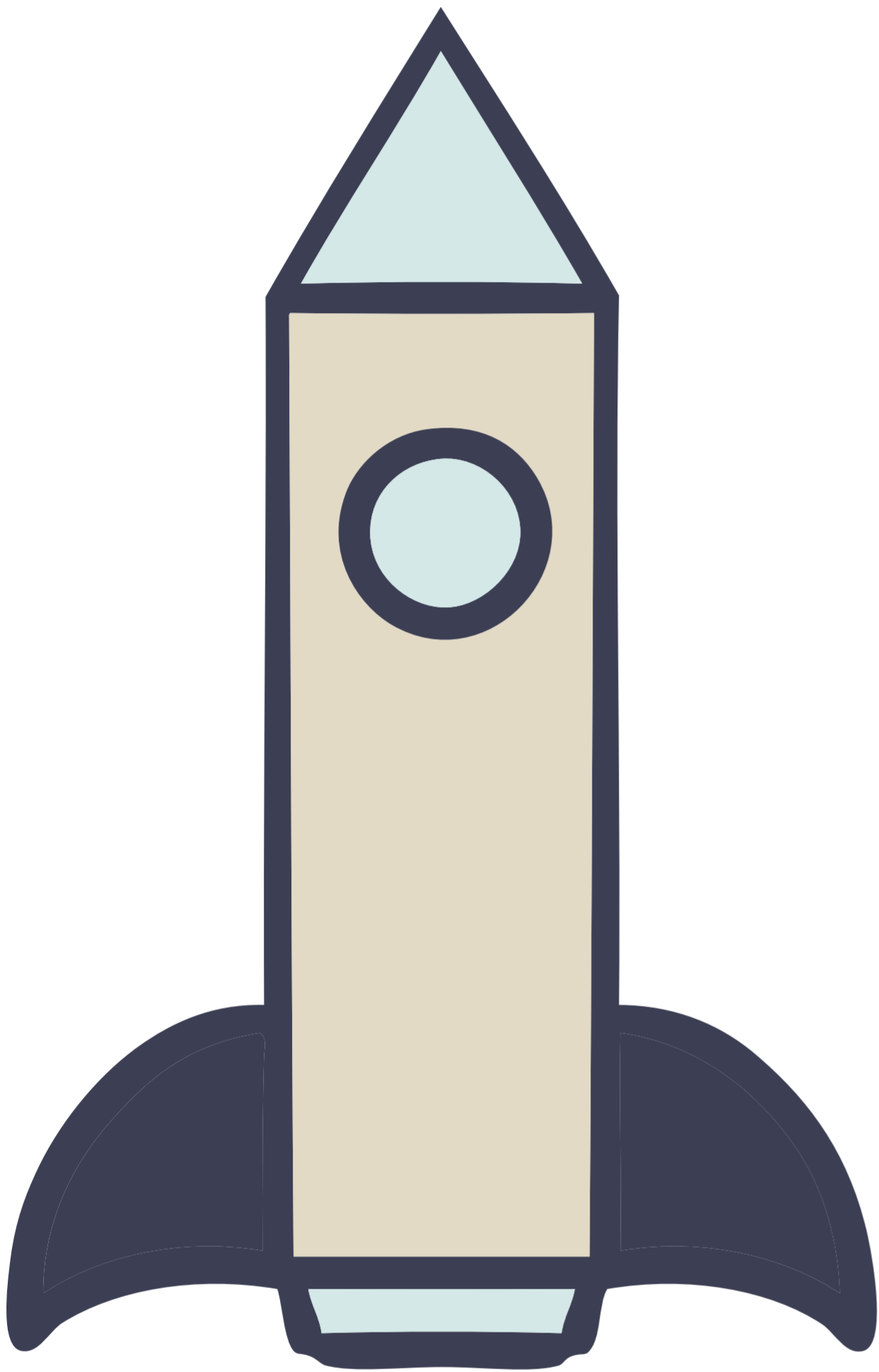


Take off!

Prekindergarten improves children's reading and writing skills. And kids who go to prekindergarten show improvements in social skills, behavior and conduct, and do better in grades K-12.

In prekindergarten, children may spend time:

- Learning the ABCs
- Making friends
- Singing songs
- Listening and following directions
- Reading stories
- Writing simple words
- Learning to write their names
- Counting to thirty
- Talking about plants and animals
- Learning about shapes
- Painting and cutting paper
- Running, jumping, playing and dancing
