Early learning in prekindergarten gives kids a strong foundation.

Your child may be eligible for free prekindergarten.

A child is eligible for enrollment in free prekindergarten if he or she is at least three years of age and:

- Unable to speak or comprehend the English language
- Is eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program
- Homeless
- The child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or the reserves
- The child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or the reserves, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty
- Is or ever has been in foster care
- The child of a police officer, firefighter, or emergency medical responder seriously injured or killed in the line of duty and received the Star of Texas Award
