Speedy Alphabet Arcs

Objective

Students will gain speed and accuracy in letter recognition.

Materials

- Speedy Alphabet Arcs handout
- Set of uppercase letters (e.g., foam or plastic)
- Timer
- For extension activities: Set of lowercase letters

Overview

Explicitly model the activity and provide multiple opportunities for practice with corrective feedback

Activity

- 1. Place the uppercase alphabet arc from the handout (consider enlarging and reprinting the arc) and set of letters on a flat surface. Place the timer at the center.
- 2. Set the timer for 1 minute.
- **3.** Have students choose a letter, name it, and place it on the corresponding letter on the alphabet arc.
- **4.** Have students continue until the timer goes off.
- **5.** Provide corrective feedback
- **6.** Repeat the activity until students can match all of the letters in less than 1 minute.


Activity Extension


- Match lowercase letters to the lowercase alphabet arc in 3 minutes or less.
- Complete the partial alphabet arc in 3 minutes or less.
