Word Sorts

Objective

Students will sort words by their sounds.

Materials

- Whiteboard or chart paper to display word categories
- Optional videos for teacher: http://texasgateway.org/resource/letter-sounds

Overview

Model and provide multiple opportunities for students to practice with corrective feedback.

Activity

- **1.** Write and display word categories, such as short *i* words, short *u* words, and short *a* words.
- **2.** Read example words and place in correct column, such as *pig* in the short *i* column, *gum* in the short *u* column, and *man* in the short *a* column.
- **3.** Have students sort other words into the categories, such as *jug, bit, pat, run, wag, big, dug, kit, cat, plan, lip, hum, tan, cub, chin, clap,* and *cut.*
- 4. Create and use other word sorts that focus on sounds. Scaffold student learning.
