# **Diphthong Matching**

## **Objective**

Students will spell and sort words with diphthongs.

#### **Materials**

- Handout 1: Diphthong Spelling and Sorting (two copies for each student)
- Handout 2: Diphthong Word List (for teacher)

#### **Overview**

Begin by modeling. Continue practicing with students until they can work independently.

## **Activity**

- 1. Distribute two copies of Handout 1 to each student, one for practice and one for the final sort.
- **2.** Explain to students that the sound /oy/, as in boy, can be spelled with the letters oy or oi.
- **3.** Tell students that you will begin with *oy* words. Read the words from the *oy* list on Handout 2, one at a time.
- **4.** After reading each word, have students write the word in *oy* column on their handout and underline the letters *oy*. Support students with spelling as needed.
- **5.** Repeat steps 3 and 4 for the *oi* words.
- **6.** Tell students to turn over their completed copy of the handout so they can't see the words and to turn to the second copy.
- **7.** Read the same words, randomly choosing between the *oi* and the *oy* words. Have students try to write each word in the correct column.
- **8.** Provide corrective feedback.
- **9.** Repeat steps 3 and 4 for the /ow/ sound words on Handout 2.
