




Depending on your classroom configuration, you may need to have students sit closer to the flip book in order to see the images clearly.













































































































Maximum Height Reache Reported As 188 Miles



### Space (Poster 1M)


- 1. the region beyond the Earth's atmosphere in which there are stars and planets (noun)




### Ship (Poster 2M)
