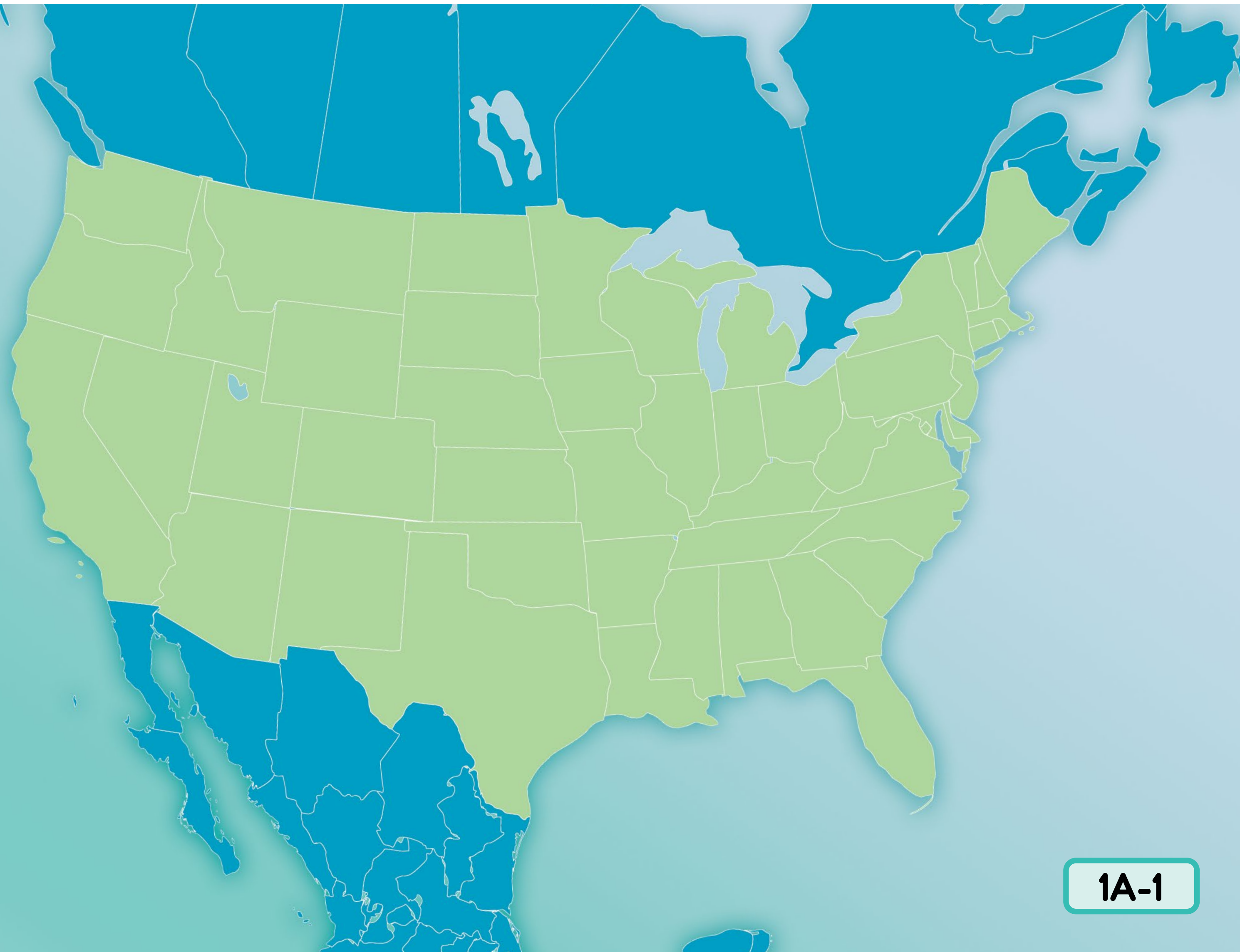

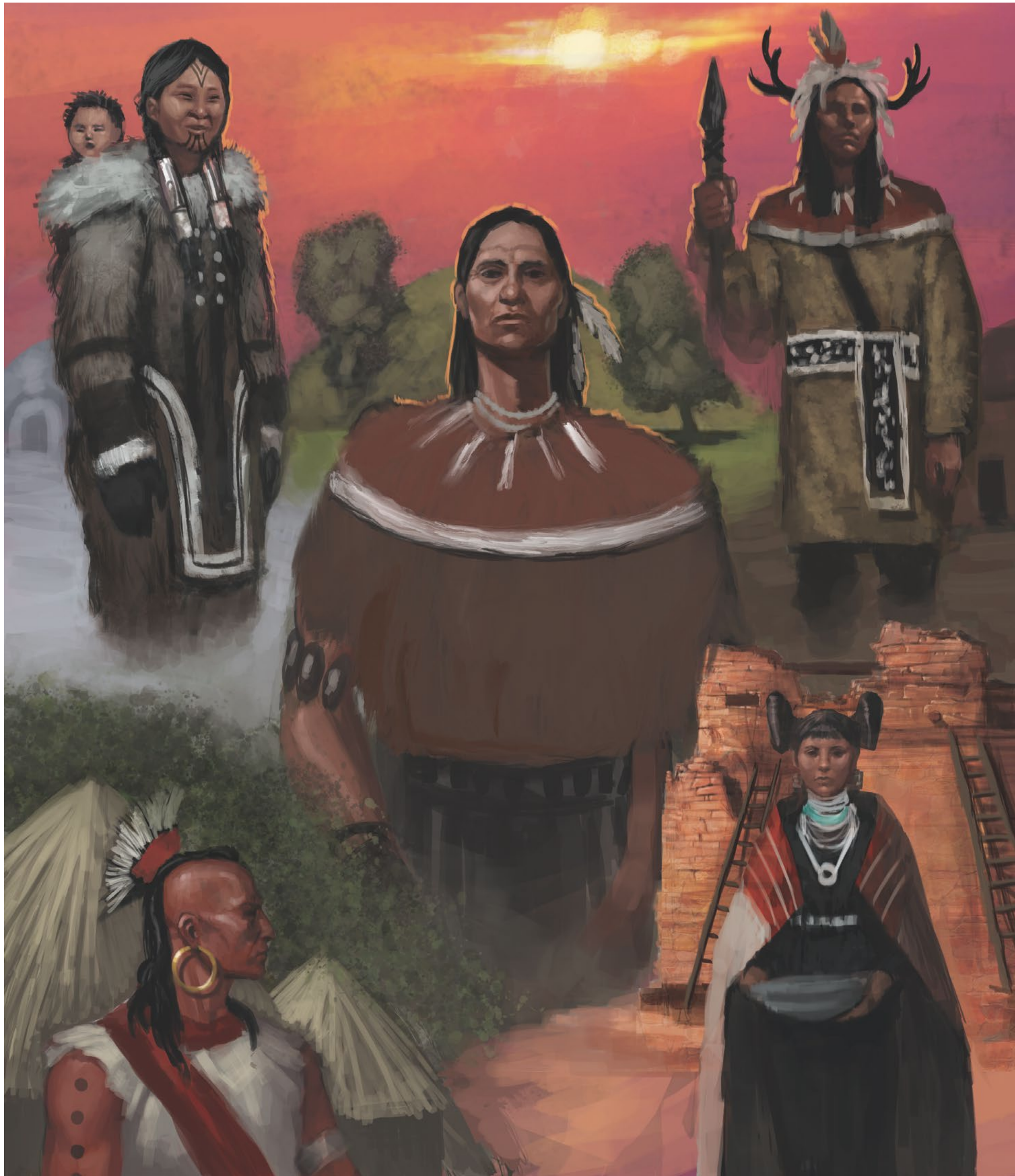
## **Flip Book Introduction**

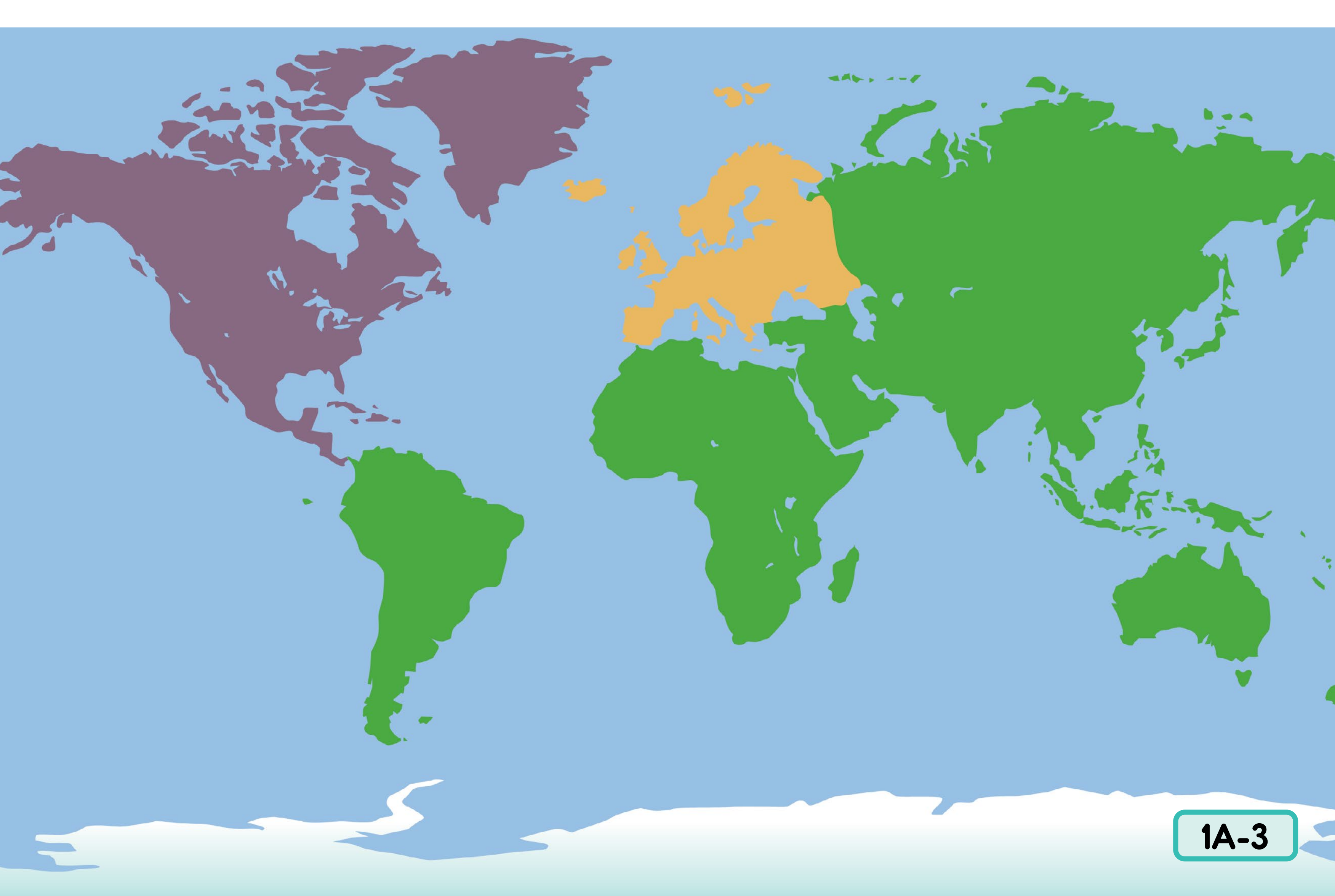
Depending on your classroom configuration, you may need to have students sit closer to the flip book in order to see the images clearly.











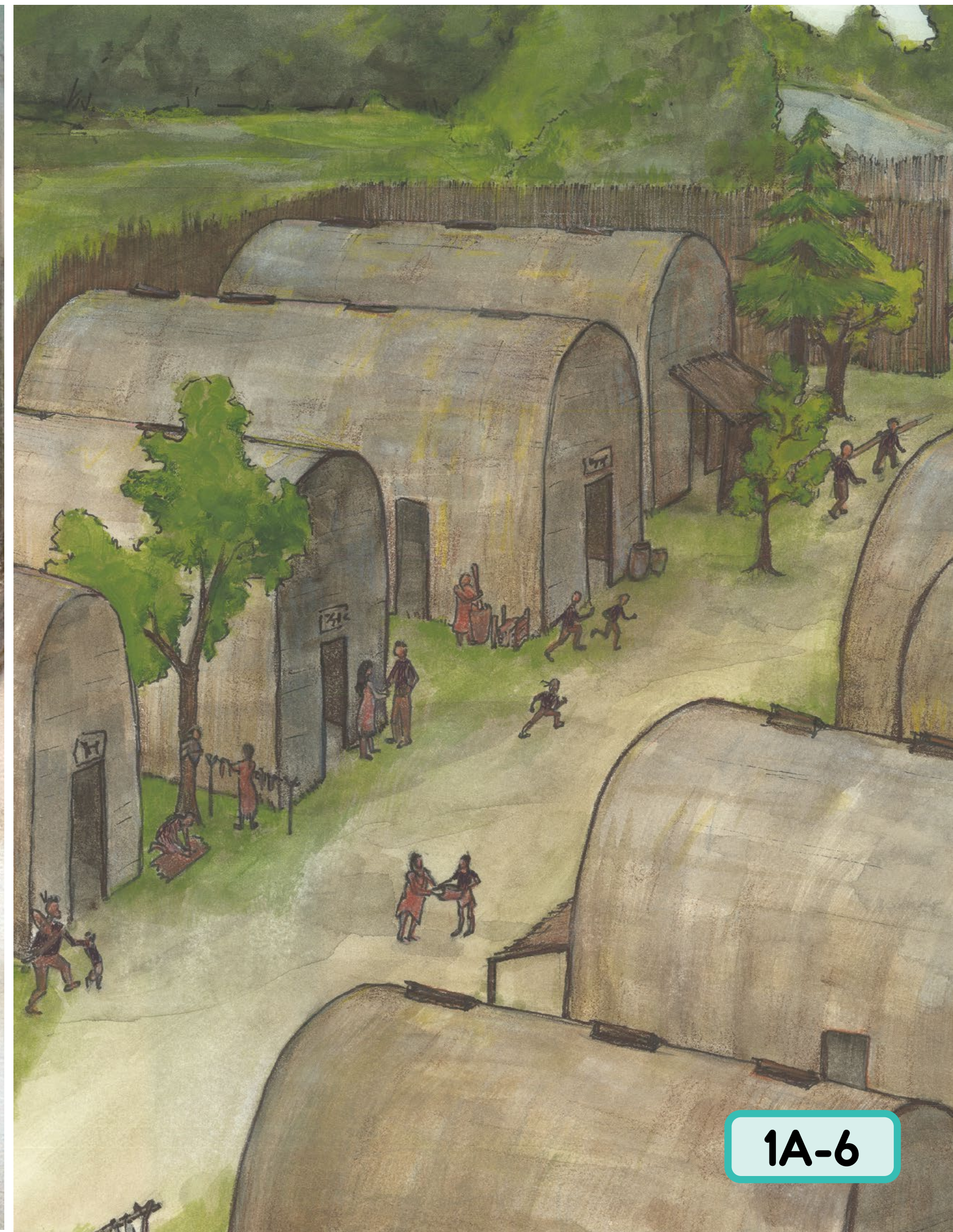




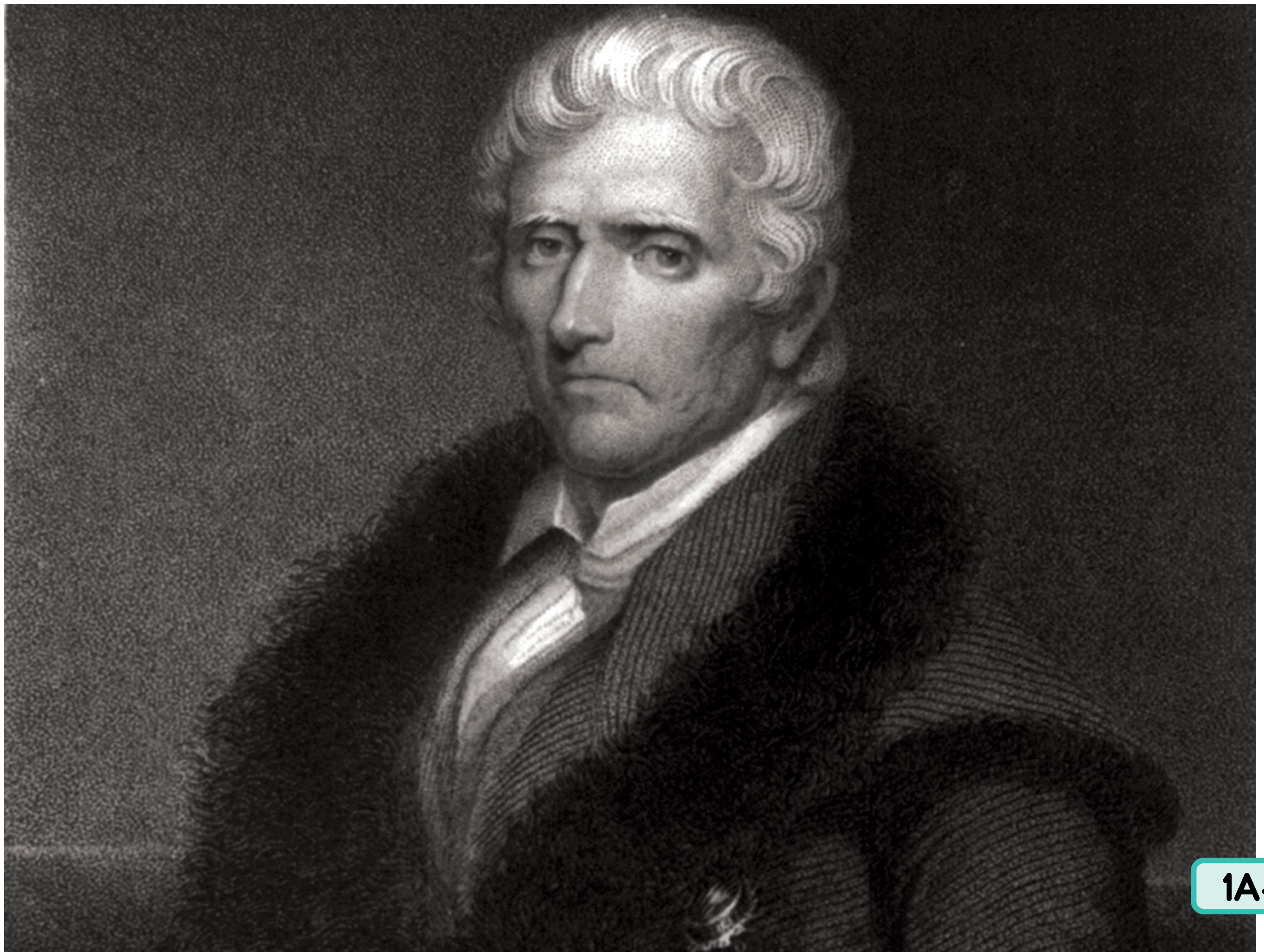






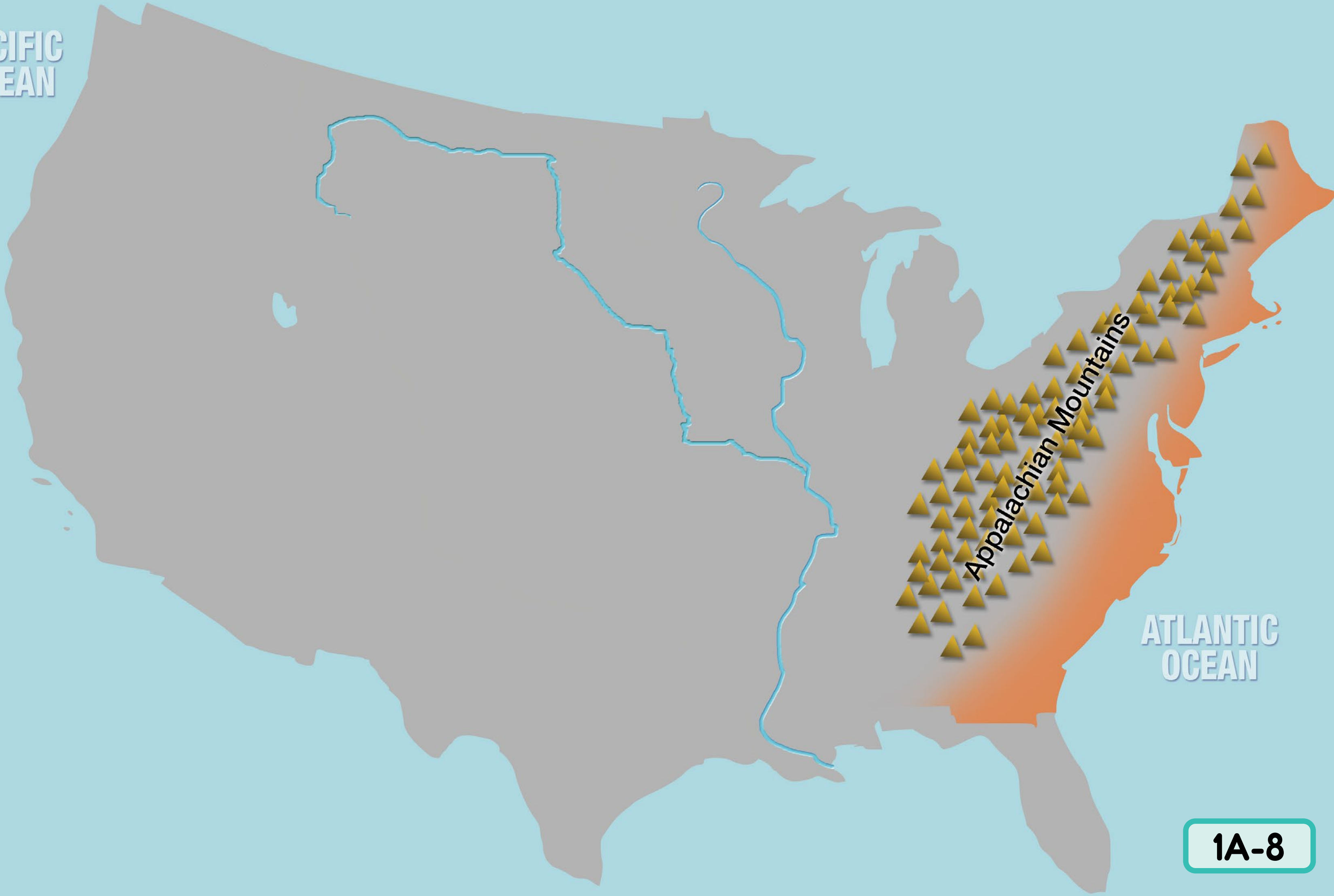
