## Grade 3, Unit 3 Foundational Skills

Dear Family Member,

In this unit, students will practice reading and spelling words with the vowel-consonant-e (VCe) pattern.

## What will my student learn?

Students will learn how to read and spell words that have the vowel-consonant-e (VCe) spelling pattern. They will learn that the final 'e' in these words often changes the pronunciation of the preceding vowel, and they will practice this concept using preceding vowels, such as:  $a_e$ ,  $i_e$ ,  $o_e$ , and  $u_e$ . Students will then learn to read and spell words with suffixes that change the VCe base word by dropping the final 'e' (e.g., bake plus –ing becomes baking). Students will also practice reading with the Reader, Healthy Humans: How to Keep Your Body Strong. The Reader educates children on the importance of physical, mental, and social health in a holistic approach to well-being. It discusses the importance of sleep, regular exercise, a balanced diet, hydration, personal hygiene, and dental care. The Reader also addresses the positive impacts of expressing emotions, building friendships, and experiencing social interactions.
