The letters ai and ay each work together as a vowel team and stand for the sound /ae/.

ai

- The /ae/ sound is usually spelled ai when it shows up at the beginning or in the middle of a word or syllable.
 - wait
 - <u>ai</u>m

ay

- The /ae/ sound is usually spelled ay when it shows up at the end of a word or syllable.
 - day
 - maybe
