<p><b>TEKS Included in Lesson:</b>  <b>THEATRE – MIDDLE SCHOOL – GRADE 7 (1)(F)</b>            Include setting, character, and plot in improvised scenes.</p>	<p><b>TEKS Included in Lesson:</b>  <b>THEATRE – MIDDLE SCHOOL 2 (b)(2)(G)</b> Creative expression: performance. The student interprets characters using the voice and body expressively and creates dramatizations. The student is expected to create improvised scenes that include setting, character, and plot</p>
<p><b>Lesson Objectives:</b>            Students will create scenes by choosing a setting, five characters, and five actions.</p>	<p><b>Lesson Objectives:</b></p>
<p><b>Instructional Activities:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Teacher divides students into groups of five.</li> <li>2. Teacher selects a setting for the group.</li> <li>3. Students “draw” a character from a character jar (identity of a specific character type on a slip of paper in a jar).</li> <li>4. Students improvises a scene for that character that includes five actions.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Instructional Activities:</b></p>
<p><b>Assessment:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Teacher ends each scene once five actions have been completed.</li> <li>2. Teacher asks for feedback from class to help identify the five actions of each scene.</li> <li>3. Teacher asks for feedback from the class to help identify the “character” of each student in the improvisation.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Assessment:</b></p>
